

Our Beis Hamikdash




At the end of the *shira*, the *Yidden* said, "Bring us to the *Beis Hamikdash* that was prepared by Your hands." Some *Meforshim** learn from this *possuk*, that the third *Beis Hamikdash* will be built by Hashem and not by the *Yidden*.

Question – How could it be that the *Yidden* will lose out on the great *zchus* and *mitzva* of building the greatest and final *Beis Hamikdash?*!

Answer – The third *Beis Hamikdash* is actually built by us, even more than the first and second *Beis Hamikdash*! The third *Beis Hamikdash* is built through all the many *mitzvos* that the *Yidden* performed with *mesiras nefesh*, throughout the many years in *golus*. In order to ensure that this *Beis Hamikdash* – that we built with our *mitzvos* – will last forever, Hashem built the physical *Beis Hamikdash*. Whatever is built by Hashem is everlasting, therefore, the third, and final *Beis Hamikdash* will last forever.

The Rebbe told us that we already completed

our *avoda* to merit the coming of *Moshiach* and the rebuilding of the *Beis Hamikdash*. We *daven* and anticipate for Hashem to do His part and bring down the third and final *Beis Hamikdash*, with the



coming of *Moshiach*. May it be speedily in our days, *amein*!
