DID YOU KNOW?

1 V'ATAH TETZAVEH: AND "YOU" SHOULD COMMAND

This is the only time Moshe's name isn't used, but rather a pronoun.

2 SHEISH MAYOS ELEF RAGLEI HA'OM ASHER ANOCHI B'KIRBOI : I STAND AMONGST THE SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PEOPLE

Moshe, a Nasi, is compared to a head of the body, while B'nei Yisroel, the Jewish Nation, is compared to the feet of the body. A head cannot move on its own. The feet help the head reach it's destination. B'nei Yisroel help Moshe reach a spiritual destination.



3 TETZAVEH: COMMAND

Although Tetzaveh's literal translation is to command, there is a deeper translation from the root "Tzavtzah," to connect.

4 RAYAH M'HEMNA: A FAITHFUL SHEPHERD

The Nasi, leader of the generation, is the Shepherd of his flock. He feeds his flock with faith in Hashem.



5 MESIRAS NEFESH: SACRIFICING ONE'S SELF

By putting one's own wants (Nefesh) aside and be totally subservient to Hashem's wants, we connect to Hashem in a complete way.

This reveals one's true essence and in turn reveals the truth in the world around them.

6 KOSIS LAMOAR: CRUSHED FOR LIGHTING

Being crushed sounds bad, but it actually brings out the best in us. When you want to get pure oil, the olive must be crushed.
