So, come along and listen,

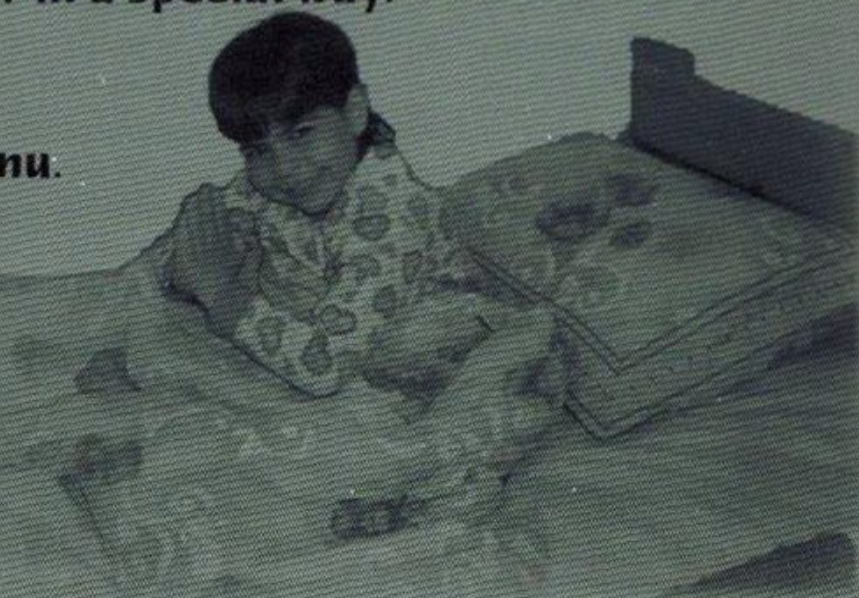
And we will show you how.

'Til we see Moshiach Tzidkeinu.

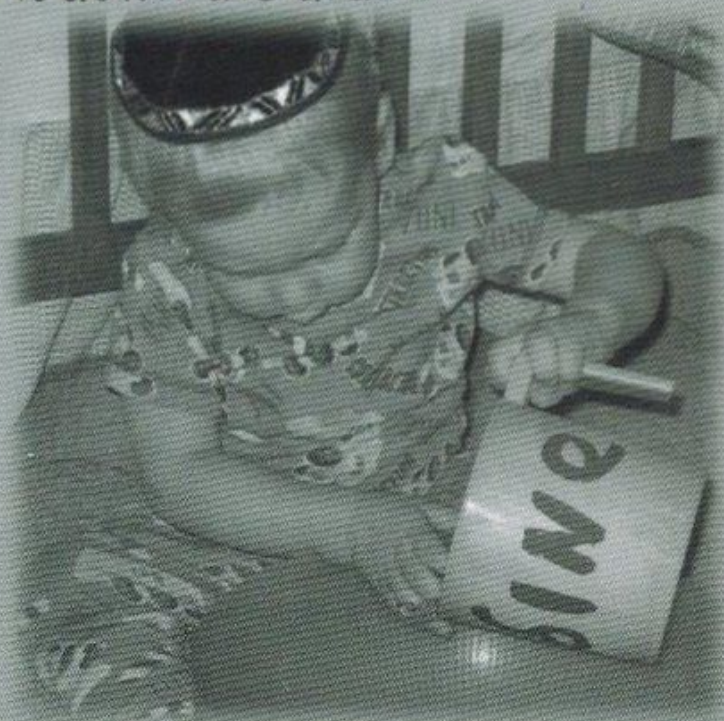


NEGEL VASSER

I say, "Modeh Ani," and reach out for my cup.

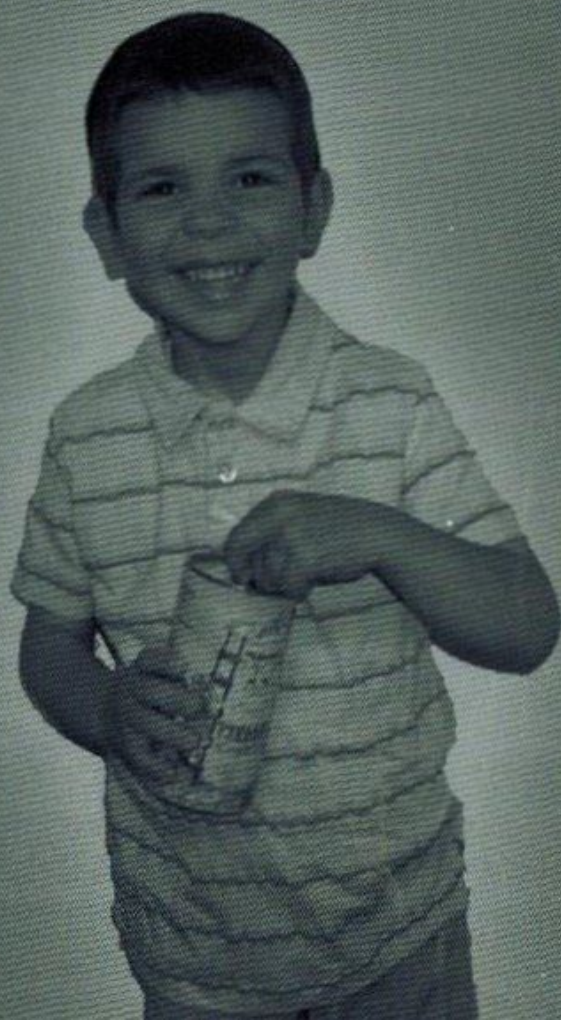
While I was sleeping, this mitzvah waited right nearby.

For unity will bring us Geuloh.

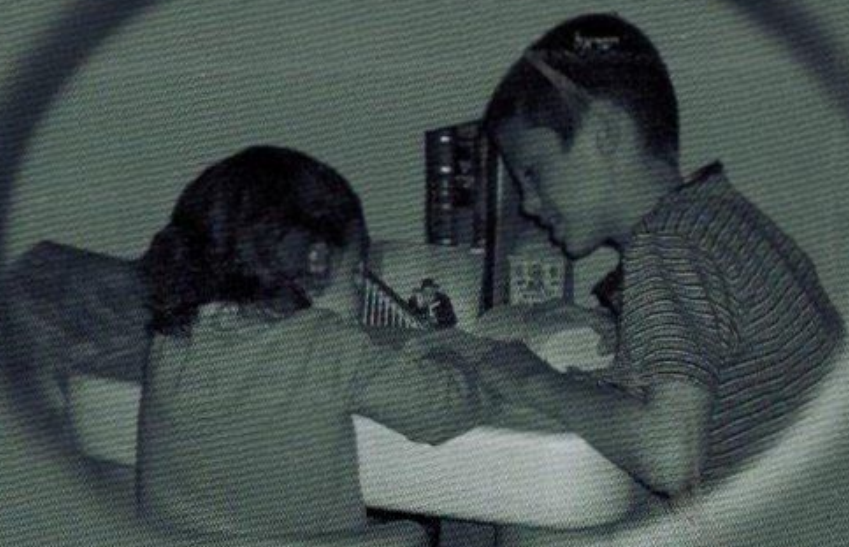


CHEDER BAIS CHABAD

BICHOL DROCHECHO

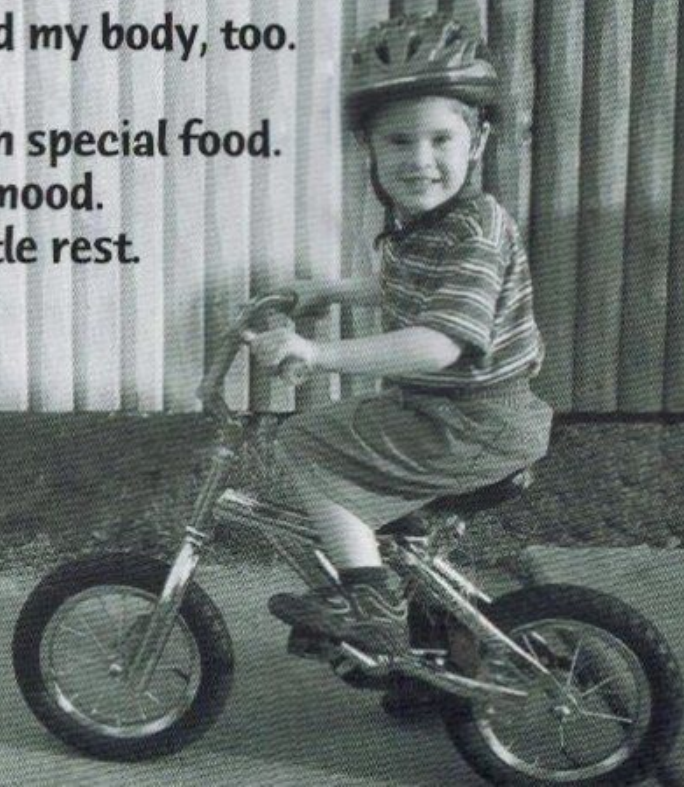
Do'EIHU

When Torah we teach.

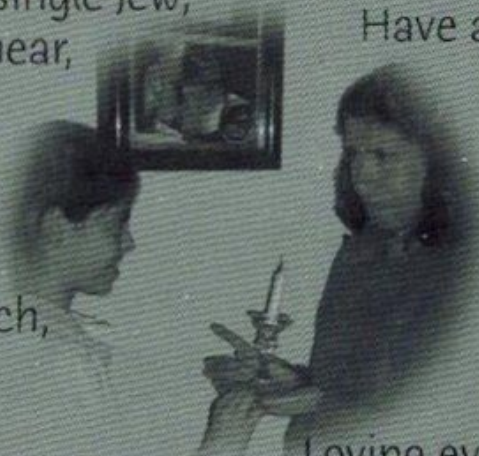
The world will then be filled with joy,

We teach these mitzvos to every single Jew.

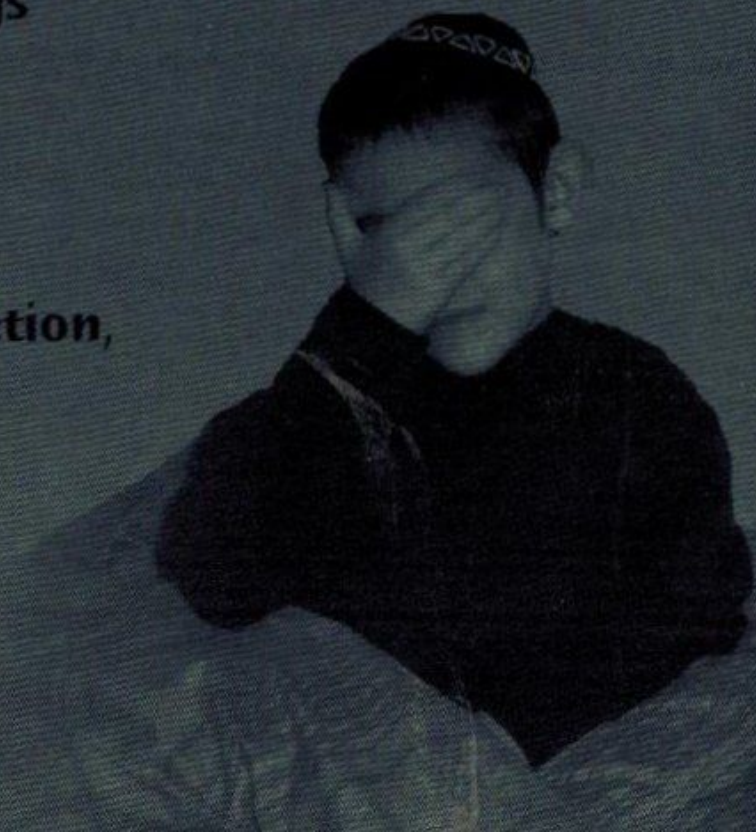


BEDTIME SONG
