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#### **PREFACE**

With gratitude to G-d, we are honored and overjoyed to present you with a special supplement: *The System of Tanya*, *Chapters 1-25*. In honor of the 19 of Kislev we designed *Tanya* visuals that will enhance our ongoing series *Lectures on Tanya*, a project that transcribes and translates Reb Yoel Khan's *Tanya shiurim*.

Reb Yoel Kahn, the chief oral scribe of the Rebbe, delivered many lectures on *Chassidut*. One renowned series was his in-depth lectures on *Tanya*, given almost 40 years ago. Reb Yoel's lectures on *Tanya* are thorough, often revisiting concepts from previous lectures, each time a little differently; with a little more depth. These lectures have been transcribed and translated from the original *Yiddish Tanya Shiurim*. They have since appeared in audio and written formats, but never in English. The original recordings have been preserved by Heichal Menachem, and have served as the basis for this project. Our ambitious goal is to present these valuable and authentic lectures to the English readership, it is our *tefillah* that we are successful in doing so.

It has been two years since the beginning of this project, and since then we have worked on the first 25 chapters of *Tanya*. Due to various reasons, we were only able to release five installments of the lecture series, some of which were printed out of order. However, it is our goal to publish them all in an organized fashion, and soon, please G-d.

The present publication is different from the other five. In fact, none of the chapter titles or questions are to be found in Reb Yoel Khan's *shiurim* on *Tanya*. However, they have been generated using the clarity and organization gained from them.

We have attempted to present not only a visual aid to the study of the first 25 chapters of *Tanya* but the system and structure of those chapters themselves. Surely we have made mistakes, and the attempt itself is quite arrogant. But isn't it the mission of our generation –the last generation of *Golut* and the first of *Geulah* –to spread the wellsprings of *Chassidut* abroad?

We our hope that these visuals assist the study of *Chassidut* in some way. May this effort to disseminate the teachings of *Chassidut* abroad be a fulfillment of our obligation, to some degree, leading us towards a peaceful era under the guidance of *Moshiach* in the Presence of G-d.

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#### INTRODUCTION

Chassidus was traditionally communicated face-to-face.

At first, the Alter Rebbe relayed the ethos of *Chassidus* in short, but fiery, discourses. Following his freedom from imprisonment, the discourses become longer, and deeper. The *manichim* (scribes) committed the words of their Rebbe with utmost reverence and precision. However, the only *Chassidus* the Alter Rebbe himself for us is the *Tanya*.

Have you ever wondered what the novelty of the *Tanya* is?

The Alter Rebbe gave us the system of *Chabad*. He codified the inner reality of the soul, and the Universe. And with it, we have an organized way to serve G-d with love and awe. Chapter after chapter, page after page, the Alter Rebbe exposes the *Benoni*—the character whom he saw could be any one of us.

The *Tanya* is a guide that counsels you through your problems and setbacks, beyond what you knew was possible. For you to serve G-d –fully –with love and awe.

Yet, sometimes the counsel may seem too foreign. Or perhaps something appears not to resonate with you. However, the Alter Rebbe constructed the *Benoni* one chapter after another. It is a magnificent system that unfolds step by step.

The key to learning *Tanya*, therefore, is to stay focused, and recognize how all the pieces of counsel come together, forming the holistic philosophy we have come to know as *Chabad*.


Each chapter of *Tanya* has its essential concept, a unique component in the total system of Tanya, but all stem from the central point: Divine service.

The goal here is to show how they are all connected. Not only because they are all chapters in the same *Sefer*, but because each chapter is a unique component in a holistic system.


#### THE FLOW OF TANYA


The Alter Rebbe writes the following in his Foreword to the *Tanya*: "...all of them are responsa to many **questions** which all our faithful in our country have constantly asked, seeking advice, each according to his station, so as to receive moral guidance in the service of G-d....I have, therefore, recorded all the **replies** to all the questions, to be preserved as a **signpost** and to serve as a **visual reminder** for each and every person, so that he will no longer press for admission to private conference with me."

The questions, however, weren't appended to the chapters of the *Tanya*. But with some effort, and a little creativity, an attempt to trace those questions can be made. With them, the flow of the structured responsa organized in the systematic chapters of the *Tanya* become clear.
